- 1. True or False: Sometimes the words in the Bible are red.
 - a. True: In some Bibles, they make all the words that Jesus said red.
- 2. True or False: Some stories are in the Bible more than one time.
 - a. True: We can read the Easter story in the books of Matthew, Mark, Luke & John, but each story was written by a different person who saw it happen.
- 3. True or False: If you see a little letter beside a word in your Bible, it doesn't mean anything.
 - a. False: This little letter tells you to look at the bottom of the page for the matching little letter. There you will find a note to help you understand what you're reading.
- 4. True or False: The page numbers of a Bible story in my Bible is on the same page number in everyone else's Bible
 - a. False: There are many different kinds of Bibles so the stories are not always on the same page numbers.
- 5. True or False: The Bible is one big book with lots of books inside of it
 - a. True: The Bible is one book made up of 66 little books. It's the same as taking all the Harry Potter books and combining them into one big book!
- 6. True or False: There is only one version of the Bible
 - a. False: There are many different versions, or translations, of the Bible. They all say the same thing, just in different ways.
- 7. True or False: The big bold numbers in the Bible are the CHAPTER number
 - a. True: (Open a Book of Mark & show kids a chapter number)
- 8. True or False: The little numbers in the Bible are the VERSE number?
 - a. True (Open a Book of Mark & show kids a chapter number)
- 9. True or false: We find Bible verses by looking for the book, then the chapter, then the verse.
 - a. True: (Show Beetle) To find a verse in the Bible, first we find the book, then the chapter (big bold number), then the verse (little number)
- 10. True or False: ALL the books of the Bible are named after the person who wrote them
 - a. False: Some of the books of the Bible are named after the person who wrote it, but some are named after an event or the people the book was written to
